

**Workshop on the development road maps for the implementation of 5 Areas of development on 02.04.19 :-**

A workshop for the teachers was organized on how to inculcate the five areas of development (Cerebral, Physical, Social, and Emotional) in the School curriculum. Our founder, Mr. Arun Kapur first expressed this concept in his book 'Leading Out' (2011). This framework endeavors to foster the holistic development of all learners to help them actualize their potential and be leaders in their own rights. This workshop was a step forward in direction of letting students develop themselves into constructive citizens of India.

**According to Mr. Kapur,**

**“Teachers ask students to demonstrate what they have learnt; transforming learning into something they want to do. Students begin to teach their peers and become leaders in their own right.”**

The very first step is for all teachers at the school to understand the 5 Areas of Development. Five teachers are needed to act as the main coordinators for each of the 5 areas. Each area then needs to be integrated into the learning framework of the school, so that they are central to the school's vision and philosophy going forward.

On 02.04.19 this first step has been taken for the implementation of the areas. All the teachers have prepared their own road maps by following the five areas of development implemented by the Royal Academy, Bhutan.
